CHAPTER UPDATES: In-Prison Ministry

FEDERAL INSTITUTIONS

Atlantic Institution

This institution is in Renous, New Brunswick. It is a maximum security facility. PFC has one volunteer going twice a week.

Dorchester Penitentiary

Located in Dorchester, New Brunswick. It is a medium and minimum security facility. PFC has two to four volunteers serving biweekly.

PROVINCIAL INSTITUTIONS

Madawaska Regional Correctional Centre (MRCC)

There are two volunteers with one French volunteer in process. The location of MRCC is Saint-Hilaire, NB.

Shediac Southeast Regional Correctional Centre

There are three volunteers going in twice a week. We are seeking one additional volunteer to join this team.

New Brunswick Youth Centre Treatment Unit

There are three volunteers going into the youth center on a monthly basis.

Mirimachi Women's Correctional Centre

Currently there are two volunteers going to the Women's correctional centre on a weekly basis.

Saint John Regional Correctional Centre

Currently there is one volunteer serving weekly and two more in training.

Dalhousie Regional Correctional Centre

We currently do not have any volunteers going into this institution. There is a church we are in contact that has expressed interest. Please join in prayer that God would provide volunteers to serve the inmates in the only provincial institution where PFC is not currently present.

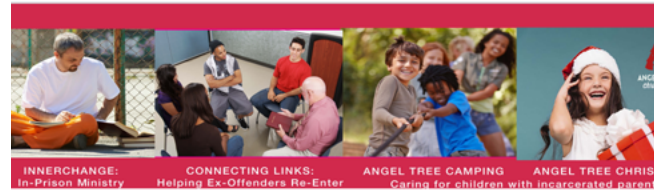
