Taking a step of faith, Cameron took responsibility for his actions by changing his plea to guilty and writing letters of repentance to those affected. Despite facing up to six more years in prison, he chose integrity over living a lie, finding deep peace in his decision. Because of your generous support, God used this step of faith to work in his life as evidenced by a transformed heart and restored integrity.

During *The Forgiveness Journey* at a correctional centre in Alberta, Anthony, a participant from a gang background, joked that forgiving facilitators for showing up was *“as close to forgiveness as he was going to get.”*

The next week, everything changed. He moved to sit right beside the team, opened up about wanting to break the cycle of revenge, and asked for prayer and a Spanish Bible.

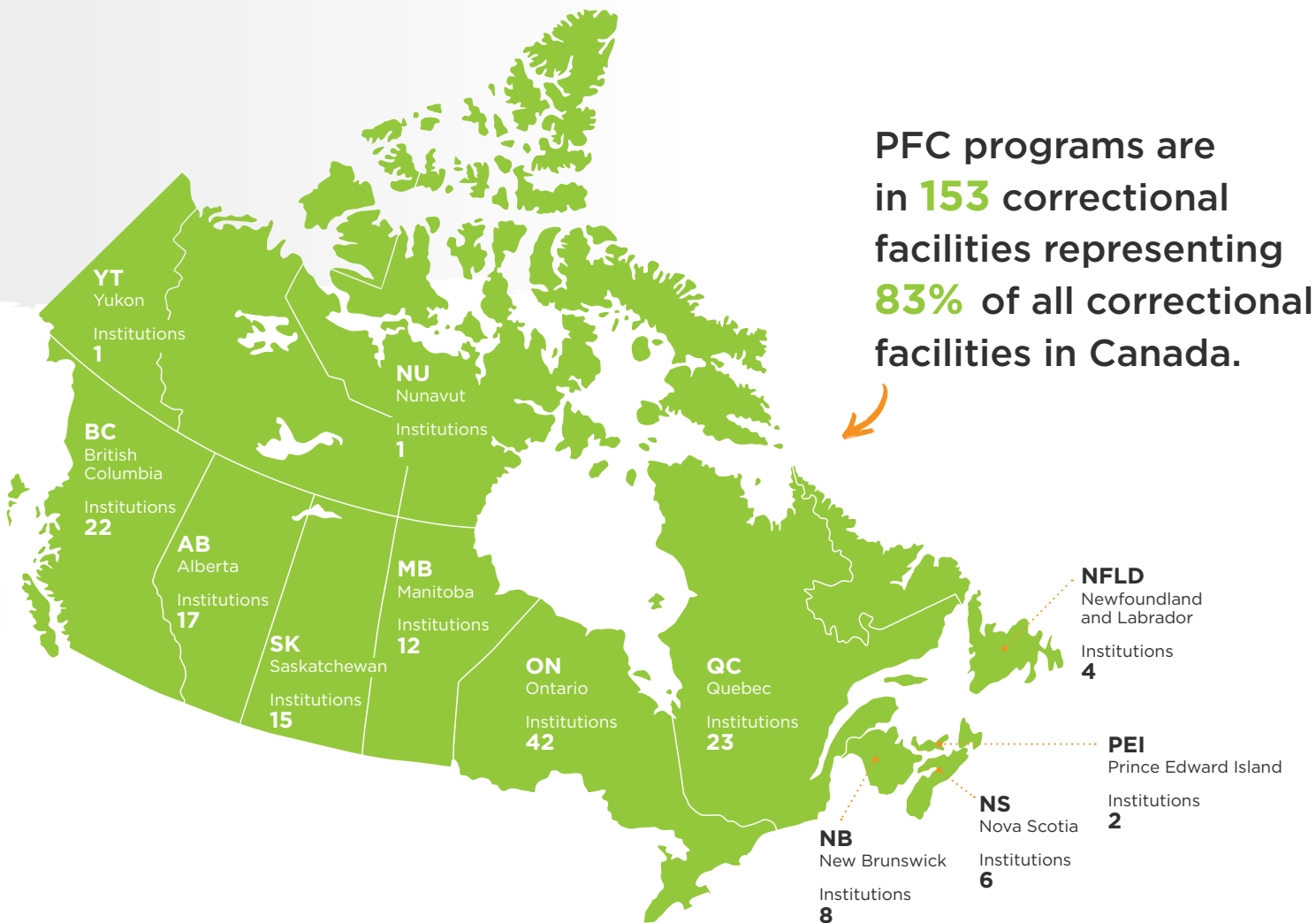
Your support makes these moments of transformation possible, fostering genuine accountability and changed behaviour behind prison walls.

BRIDGECARE

When someone is released from prison, they often step into a world that feels unfamiliar and overwhelming. Reintegration is a critical moment, and support through our programs helps ensure they do not face it alone.

In Bridgecare, participants receive emotional, spiritual, and practical support as they rebuild their lives and reconnect with the community.

Currently, we have 235 participants in the program, with 37 new applicants awaiting team matches. We need an additional 125 new volunteers to answer God's call into this area of ministry. Every volunteer receives comprehensive training and serves alongside a partner in teams of two.

You are part of each participant's homecoming story. Because of your generosity, people leaving prison can find encouragement, accountability, and a new community that shows them they are not alone as they begin their journey toward a new life.

After completing *The Re-Entry Journey* Bible study, Richard, a formerly incarcerated man in Quebec completely turned his life around. Now employed and stably housed, he shares with everyone how God's love and mercy gave him a new attitude and fresh outlook.

Your support provides individuals with the biblical tools to build a stable, transformed life after release.
