A LOOK AT ALBERTA

On June 4th, we were excited to gather with volunteers and supporters at our Prayer and Pancake Breakfast in Cochrane – spending time together, praying over the work of Prison Fellowship Canada (PFC), and thanking God for faithfully opening doors and hearts to this ministry. The Holy Spirit covered the meeting, and the attendees were filled with compassionate commitment.

While we wait to access institutions, the Lord has provided other opportunities for PFC in the province. New PFC by Phone and Bridgecare volunteers have come forward. Currently, fifteen Alberta volunteers are on the phone line, offering prayer and spiritual encouragement to prisoners. One volunteer reported, “Praise God this was an awesome day as I was truly blessed to have five callers today and pray with each one. God is truly at work in PFC Ministries.”

By the grace of God, opportunities are also opening up in central Alberta; the chaplain at the Red Deer Remand approached us regarding in-prison programming, and while we wait for the institution to officially open to volunteers, churches have gotten involved. Volunteers have come forward to start the vetting and training process. As we have been meeting with pastors and church groups, it is clear that God is at work in the region.

We have a new partnership with The Mustard Seed in Calgary and Edmonton. Together we will work on identifying new candidates for the Bridgecare program. PFC is looking to train more volunteers for Bridgecare and to run **The Forgiveness Journey** through The Mustard Seed. Please prayerfully consider joining us for this new opportunity.

It is Angel Tree Camping season! This year we have twelve children registered in summer camps. A caregiver says, “I am thankful for Angel Tree giving my children the chance to have fun and go to camp. Thank you for supporting us in a world where we feel alone.”

The Alberta team is growing! Brenda Hilling has been joined by Tara Hilman, to work together co-managing the region. Having worked for PFC in a different capacity for three years, Tara is delighted to work in her home province.

Together, we solicit your continued prayer and support. As, Lord willing, institutions open up, we ask for special prayer for new and returning volunteers to answer the needs. We invite you to get in touch if you have any interest or questions about the work of PFC in Alberta.

On September 10, 2022, PFC is hosting our Ride for Hope event. This will be an opportunity to meet other PFC supporters and enjoy biking or walking to raise funds for Angel Tree programs. Please visit prisonfellowship.ca/r4h to sign up or support participants.

The PFC By Phone program continues to provide life-changing, spiritual friendships to prisoners in Canada. A volunteer shares a recent experience with a caller saying:

This caller was in segregation. I suggested reading from Psalms. I was thinking about which Psalm, and she said Psalm 30 as her favourite verse is "Weeping may last through the night, but joy comes with the morning" (v. 5). As we chatted before reading the Scripture, she mentioned that she was looking forward to getting into her regular prison clothes upon leaving segregation. I opened my Bible and began reading.

We reached the end of the Psalm and came upon these verses (11, 12): "You have turned my mourning into joyful dancing. You have taken away my clothes of mourning and clothed me with joy, that I might sing praises to you and not be silent. O Lord my God, I will give you thanks forever!" What a beautiful picture this new clothing gives of true restoration and hope.

BRIDGECARE

PFC's Bridgecare program continues to offer the support of our volunteers to individuals shortly

before or just after release. PFC can provide ideas for practical referrals and/or spiritual support.

A prisoner, who is serving a life sentence, will be released this summer. She has connected to the Bridgecare program and has monthly phone sessions with a Bridgecare staff member. PFC will match her with a team upon arrival at a transition house.

The team is currently writing letters with her. She communicated that she is also a proud graduate of **The Sycamore Tree** curriculum. It had a life-changing impact on her that she will take into a community. Here is how she describes the experience: **Sycamore Tree was by far the best curriculum I have ever taken in prison. Even though I took it three years ago, it has permanently changed me. The ripple effect of my actions helped me realize the toll my incarceration had taken on my daughter - particularly her unspoken burden to help me financially. In prison, I am more respectful to staff, and I encourage others to do the same.**

Being an incarcerated parent is challenging. When I learned about Angel Tree programs, I signed up my daughter. When she enrolled in Angel Tree Camping, I was anxious at first but later learned that she enjoyed it. I was blessed to be able to bring something positive into her life. She had a great time camping, making new friends, and learning about Jesus. This experience gave us a more profound love for Jesus and the church's support.

Pathway to Change

On April 7, 2022, PFC introduced a fresh look along with a new tagline, "Pathway to Change". This pathway can begin as early as the moment of incarceration. PFC walks alongside those who desire change towards renewal – in prison, leaving prison, in community and within our churches – this renewal is a result of transformation in Jesus Christ, and the restoration of dignity.

The new PFC logo shows the three pillars of PFC's ministry – prisoners, ex-prisoners and their families. The raggedness of the pillars speaks to the brokenness of those we serve, and while in an imperfect state, can be made to stand straight. With a soft cross peaking

in the middle, one sees the hope, redemption and second chances that are found in Jesus Christ.

This is PFC's mission – to open the door to transformation by mobilizing the Christian Church to respond to the issue of crime – to pave the way for God to take what has fallen over and set it up straight.

We also launched a new website designed to clearly communicate all of PFC's programs, to help people better understand the ministry and learn how to get involved.

MESSAGE FROM THE CEO

The past few months have been incredible for PFC, we have been in awe of God's blessings over the ministry. We saw closed doors open, and favour for the ministry increase nationally.

In April, we launched an updated PFC brand along with a new tagline that better describes PFC's journey with those who are affected by crime. We thank God for the smooth transition and look forward to what God will do through the new branding.

Last Quarter, we were blessed with a number of opportunities that we want to share with you:

A major component of the Restorative Prison program pilot has been the training of Youth Service Officers. This training began with mental health first aid and trauma-informed care. This Quarter we continued and completed core restorative justice program training with the first cohort of Officers. We are looking forward to see how God will work through this program. As we launch ***The Sycamore Tree*** later this year, we will continue to encourage a restorative approach between residents as well as in their interaction with staff.

Bible printing and shipments were delayed across the globe in the first half of this year. Institutional chaplains have been experiencing the effects of this as they seek to supply prisoners' requests for access to Scripture. PFC was able to procure 600 NIV Bibles and 1,400 NLT Bibles to bridge the gap. This will help us supplement our programs and support chaplains.

We are excited to set up channels for donated clothing to those being released at Vanier's Women's Centre in Ontario. This will help them get back on their feet and build up their confidence.

We thank God and praise Him for paving the road every day for the work of this ministry. We look forward to seeing what He has planned for the rest of the year as we continue to praise Him for His providence and grace. We are grateful for your ongoing partnership and prayers.
