Receiving and experiencing God's forgiveness is a lifelong process as the Lord draws us closer to Himself and brings the deepest depths of darkness that exists within our hearts to light. We pray for this maturing process for those we serve and ourselves through this ministry, and for continued growth throughout the process.

## 4 Angel Tree Camping

We continue to pray that many children of prisoners would get the opportunity to experience the memory-making, joyful experience of camp this summer. We pray that prisoners would respond favourably to in-prison posters and see the opportunity as something beneficial to their child's development.

## 5 Angel Tree Investment

We pray that the Lord would raise up many financial supporters with a deep desire to see these precious little ones experience a week of camp, community, and fun! We pray that the good things that are learned at camp would be deeply rooted in each heart.

## 6 Internal Developments

We pray for wisdom, sharpened senses, and productive critical thinking as we continue to brainstorm new solutions for managing the ministry. We pray that PFC staff can spend much time with the Christian community serving prisoners, ex-prisoners, and their families.

## 7 Favour in the Atlantic

As our opportunities continue to increase for in-prison Bible studies in the Atlantic region, we pray for more in-prison volunteers to rise up from churches that are located near the various institutions. We pray that the Lord would do something powerful and new through PFC in the Atlantic region.

## 8 Skills Development Funding

We pray that if the Lord wills, we would see an answer to our application for renewed funding for this crucial support to returning citizens. We thank the Lord for the positive ways that it has encouraged and assisted reintegration for many this past year.

## 9 Developing Leaders

We thank the Lord for the growth we've seen in volunteer participation these past few months and continue to pray over each person. We pray that the Lord is continuing to cultivate the good work He has begun; protecting our volunteers in every necessary way along the path and establishing each one in the place that He has placed them.

## 10 Affirmation & Confirmation

We thank the Lord for the many believers across Canada who are attentive to the call of the Spirit to serve prisoners, ex-prisoners, and their families. We pray that the Lord will continue to encourage those He has set apart for this ministry with the necessary confirmations so that they can faithfully take the next step.

## 11 Revelation by the Spirit

We pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to be poured out in prisons across Canada making the Word of Life stand up from the pages of Scripture like braille to each one who reads it. We pray that our in-prison studies would overflow with participants deeply longing to learn about Jesus!

## 12 Dreams & Visions

We continue to pray for revelation and clear interpretations to dreams and visions for prisoners that challenges those things that are too difficult to discuss. We pray that prisoners would find healing, deliverance, encouragement, and freedom through the revelation that comes through dreams.

## 13 Faith for the Long Game

We pray for a holy realignment in perspective for those prisoners so focused on 'getting out of prison' that they miss the deeper things God is intending to show them through this divinely orchestrated 'time out' from life. We pray for a perspective shift that is willing to consider that God is ultimately in control of our lives.

## 14 Safety for Prisoners

We often hear about the dangerous culture of Canadian prisons, but we pray that just as God was able to deliver Daniel, Joseph, Moses, and so many others in history from peril, that the Lord would preserve the lives of his incarcerated children until the day they make it home again.

## 15 The Necessity of Community

Though the experience of incarceration can often draw individuals deeper in the darkness of solitude, we pray that the Lord would destroy polarizing perspectives and instead impart the mind of Christ in prisoners who can see the value, benefits, and blessing of participation in a healthy community.

## 16 A Request for Miracles

We implore the Lord to do exceedingly beyond what we could ever hope or expect in requesting the Lord to establish prisoner baptisms as a permanent staple in prisons across Canada. As a marker of new birth, we pray this crucial declaration of faith would help to establish the new identity of Christian prisoners.

## 17 The Lowest of the Low

Although prison isn't always perceived by every prisoner as the lowest they can descend before the desire for change is apparent, we do pray for those who have decided 'no more'. We pray that just as the catapult is pulled back to launch something in the opposite direction, that the lives of the prisoners who desire change would be met by overwhelming support to achieve it.

## 18 Bridgecare Mentors

We pray that across Canada in every place where returning citizens are scheduled to go this year, that the Lord would go before us and prepare a volunteer team with His heart to see them succeed. We pray that many new Bridgecare mentors will find their way to PFC's Bridgecare training this year.

## 19 PFC By Phone Volunteers

We thank the Lord for the many phone operators who offer a compassionate ear, wise guidance, and spiritual friendship through their service. We pray that the Lord continues to give each one the wisdom necessary to address whatever situations may arise, while operating within the boundaries of the program.

## 20 PFC by Phone Openings

As the seasons change, so do the schedules of volunteers. We pray that the Lord will go before us to meet every new opening this year with an already prepared answer to fill it! We pray that no prisoner will ever call the PFC by Phone lines and not find a dedicated volunteer ready to speak with them.

## 21 The Right Candidate(s)

As we find opportunities to grow our PFC team across the country, we pray for divine introductions to the people God has purposed to serve alongside this administration. We pray that the Lord would give our senior team the clarity and confirmation we need to proceed with the delicate process of staffing so that the ministry can flourish according to His will.

## 22 The Language of Heaven

As we continue to prepare new curriculum - or to develop our existing ones, we pray that the Holy Spirit would give us just the right words in every circumstance to know how to address the difficult topics in a way that will land perfectly with our in-prison audiences.

## 23 The Families of Prisoners

We pray that Angel Tree Camping would be a time for the families of prisoners to experience the rest and restoration we all need throughout our journey. We pray that the Lord would ordain each step - whether knowingly or unknowingly - to lead each caregiver on the path of the kind of healing and growth that they each require.

## 24 Eyes That See

So often we can get blinded by our own pursuits that we miss what the Lord is intending to do through our efforts. We pray that every staff, volunteer, partner, and supporter would find the necessary shift of paradigm where applicable in their personal journey, so that we can glory in seeing and knowing that His plans alone shall prevail.

## 25 Missional Wildfires

We pray that a renewed sense of mission for prison ministry would spread to key places in Canada that surround provincial and federal prisons. We pray that there would be no volunteer need in Canada that is not amply met with an overflowing abundance of available volunteers through the local Christian church community.

## 26 Geographical Support

We pray that new streams of financial support will rise up across the country to establish and sustain the work being accomplished in each region with a long-term vision in mind. Just as the Christian church wasn't built in a day, we pray for partners with a vision for what the Lord is preparing to come.

We pray that the Lord would anoint every Bible that enters a prison with power that supernaturally draws prisoners and fills them with the desire to read His Word and the understanding to comprehend it.

## 30 In-Prison Programs

We lift up our core curriculums across Canada and pray that in every place where the person of Jesus is discussed that the Holy Spirit will bring forth an understanding and revelation of the Christ to all. We pray that the concepts of forgiveness, identity, meaning and purpose would be deeply imparted to each participant.

## 31 Breakthrough!

We pray that all the work that is needed to surround and support a supernatural breakthrough would continue to be established by the Lord in all the variety of ways needed to move the ministry forward. May this be a year of walking into greater influence and authority.
