1 Spirit Move!

We ask God to breathe on the inmates at the South Detention Centre to receive the Holy Spirit as we continue the introduction to 'Jesus the Prisoner' through our Prisoner's Journey program today. Bless the entire prison with a sense of the love, acceptance, and forgiveness of God.

2 Hand-in-Hand Labouring Together

We ask the Lord to open the hearts and hands of many to give in support of the work we do. May there be opportunities for new donors to learn about Prison Fellowship this year and how our work benefits incarcerated men and woman that stirs them to get involved financially.

3 TPJ in Manitoba

We pray for open doors for The Prisoner's Journey throughout the Manitoba region. We ask for the Holy Spirit to direct our Regional Rep, Larry Wilson straight to - and through - those doors. May God also raise up many gifted teachers in the Manitoba region to facilitate the outpouring of opportunities that abound from our prayers.

4 The Peace of God

We ask that God will preserve a spirit of peace that surpasses all understanding throughout Canadian prisons as He draws many to call upon His name, and give opportunity for them to come to a revelation of the Prince of Peace himself - the Lord Jesus Christ!

5 Justice & Righteousness

We want to see God's justice roll on like torrents of water, and righteousness like a never-failing stream! We are asking God to rectify the broken and useless systems that have been put in place that offer no place for true justice or righteousness to abound among Canadian prisons. Reconcile, redeem, & restore, Oh Sovereign God!

6 Fire of the Holy Ghost

We pray for the reconstruction of Southeast Regional Correctional Centre after the fire last year. We pray that the only fire that would consume Canadian prisons would be the fire of the Holy Spirit!

7 AfterCare

We ask for a major outpouring of networking connections to help facilitate a fruitful and edifying AfterCare program that meets the various needs of returning citizens across Canada.

8 Lord, Bless Our Volunteers

May the Lord so bless those who give their time to the various PFC ministries with every grace, provision, protection, and encouragement. We pray that just as they have given themselves to helping others, the Lord will raise up any helps that they might require in their personal lives.

9 Pen Pal Training

We pray that as more volunteers come forward to engage in our Pen Pal ministry, that God would bless them with the preparation of hearts to both give and receive from this ministry while developing godly correspondence with inmates.

10 TPJ in NFLD, PEI, NS, & NB

We ask that God will give us favour and allow PFC to teach the Prisoner's Journey in every institution that does not currently have this program in the Atlantic region. We pray that many souls will be drawn into a living and vibrant relationship with Jesus our Lord.

11 The Present of Presence

We ask that God will grace incarcerated men and women across Canada with the only gift that is available year-round - the present of His loving presence! May there be many testimonies of what the transforming love of God has accomplished in the hearts of inmates seeking a Saviour.

12 Voluntary Volunteers!

We pray that the Lord of the Harvest will draw in many more Spirit-filled workers with the passion, wisdom, and divine calling to pursue ministry with Prison Fellowship Canada. May the Lord also give us wisdom on how to recognize those who are called to be set apart for this ministry.

We ask that God will begin to supernaturally manifest Himself in powerful visions and dreams; in prophetic words of counsel and hope - all throughout Canadian prisons this year. Let there be an outpouring like we've never seen before. Lord, help us in our unbelief of what is truly possible with You.

16 BC Regional Representative



27 Revelation

We ask that the Holy Spirit will give our staff and volunteers the spiritual discernment to properly perceive the needs of those we serve so that we can effectively pray into those needs.

28 Whose Leaf Does Not Withther

May the Lord give our staff and volunteers rest from our labours, and nourishment like a tree planted by streams of water. May even our rest bear fruit, pleasing unto the Lord.
